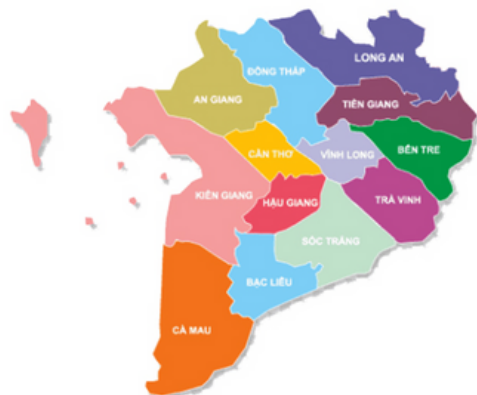
Making Aquaculture Cooperatives in the Mekong River Delta Inclusive and Bankable

The Making Aquaculture Cooperatives in Mekong River Delta Inclusive and Bankable (MACIB Mekong) Project aims to make aquaculture cooperatives organizationally and financially independent and more inclusive. Funded by the Dutch Government, this two-year project is carried out by a joint effort of the Agriterro team and stakeholders with strong collaboration of aquaculture and private sectors, local stakeholders, shrimp and pangasius smallholder farmers in 6 selected provinces: Tra Vinh, Soc Trang, Ca Mau, Bac Lieu, Can Tho, Dong Thap

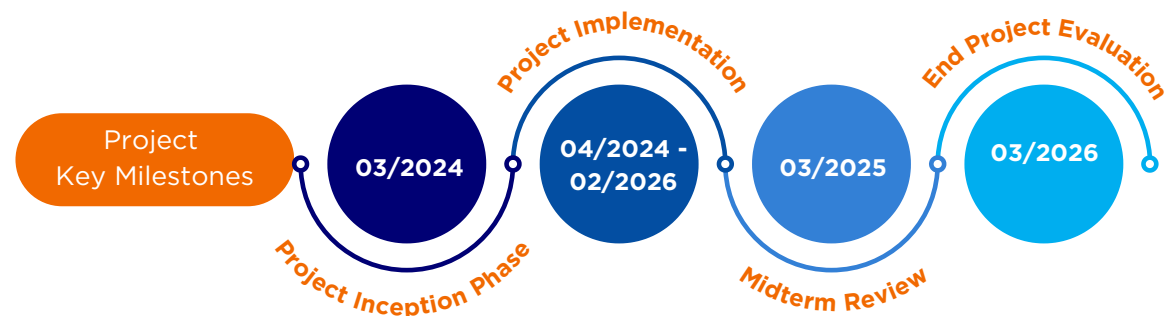
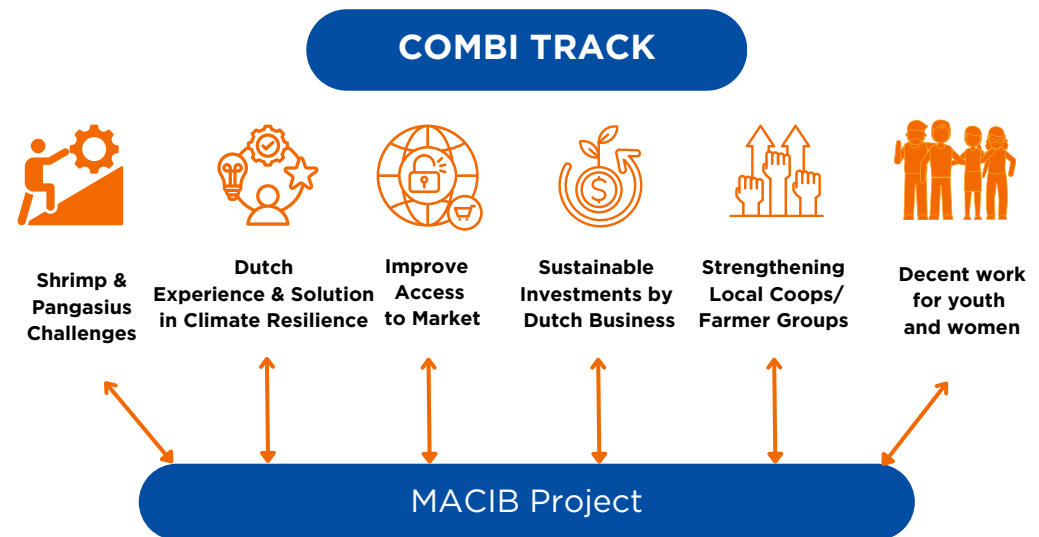
